

What is special with Mount Nebo? Nebo = prophet The summit is only 808 m. Compared to 3 Sisters: 922 metres, 918 and 906 metres in height.

But there is something more special than its geographical feature.



The highest point of the mountain called Syagha.

Maybe this is the place where God showed the whole Land of Promise to Moses. It is mentioned as the place where **Moses was granted a view of the Promised Land (LOOKOUT)**.

The view from the summit provides a panorama of the land and, to the north, a more limited one of the valley of the River Jordan. The West Bank city of Jericho is usually visible from the summit, as is Jerusalem on a very clear day.







which I give to the children of Israel as a possession;






Moses to Die on Mt. Nebo

⁵² Yet **you shall see** the land before *you*, though **you shall <u>not</u> go** there, into the land which I am giving to the children of Israel."

Mount Nebo is the place where God **consistently** declared His holiness and the consequences toward anyone transgressed His holiness! Having said that, the holiness of God **cannot be separated** with His love, His forgiveness. So, we can say that Mount Nebo is also the place where God **consistently** declared His forgiveness toward anyone who repent and back to God's way.



"Did Not Hallow ME"

Moses & Aaron did not hallow God at Meribah Num.20:11-12

- ¹¹ Then Moses lifted his hand and struck the rock twice with his rod; and water came out abundantly, and the congregation and their animals drank.
- What does it mean?

• 12 Then the LORD spoke to Moses and Aaron, "Because you did not believe Me, to hallow Me in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore you shall not bring this assembly into the land which I have given them."

So, what is the sins of Moses? What was actually happen? Hallow = holy

What is actually his mistake? Struck the rock twice? His words?

"Did Not Hallow ME"

Moses **spoke rashly** with his lips *Psa.106:32-33*

They angered Him also at the waters of strife, so that it went ill with Moses on account of them;
 Because they rebelled against His Spirit, so that he spoke rashly with his lips.

If anyone does not stumble in word, he is a perfect man, able also to bridle the whole body. **James 3:2**



We must be careful with our mouth.
