My Savior Jesus is mine*



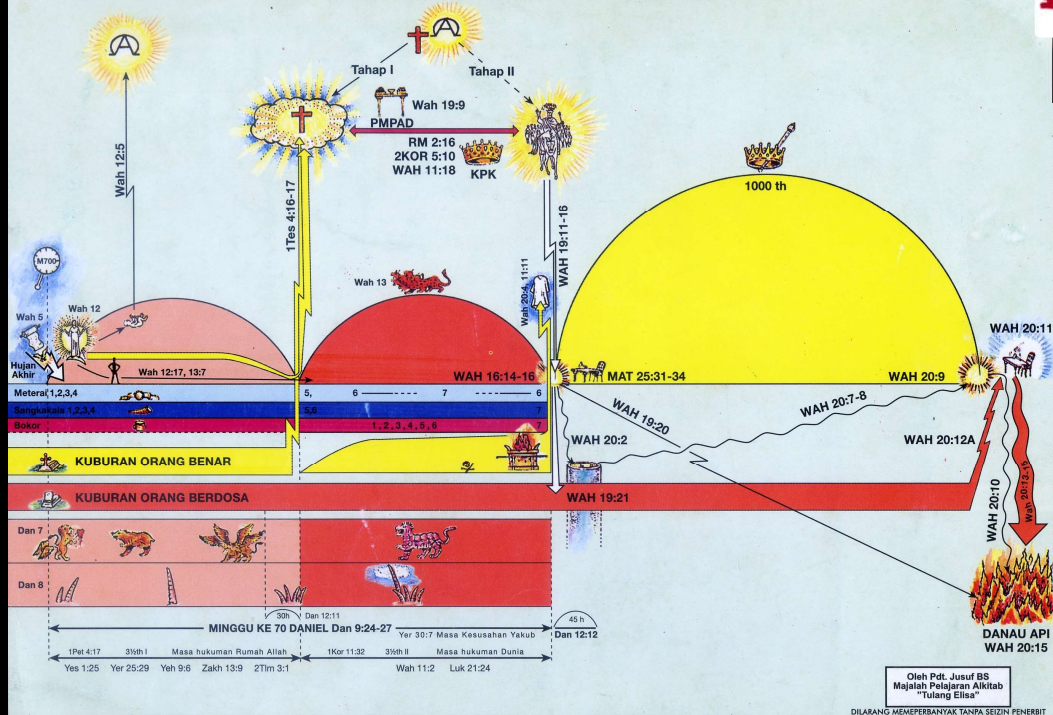
There are so many Bible verses and passage about second coming of Jesus Christ. Mostly we can find the narrative in the second-half book of Daniel (chapter 7-12), also in the whole book of Revelation (chapter 1-22). Having said that, actually the truth about the second coming of Jesus Christ and the end of this world can be found every where in the Bible, e.g. in the book of Genesis, the Psalms, the book of prophets, the Gospel, and the Paul's epistle.

There are also so many events that will happen around the 2nd coming of Christ and at the end of this world. And somehow it makes believers confuse with the chronology of al those events. Some of those events are: the rapture, the millennium, the Armageddon, the lake of fire, the final judgement, the great white throne, the 1st resurrection, the 2nd death, the antichrist, and so on.

Some of the cues that we can find:

- “And **after** the sixty-two weeks Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself; And the people of the prince who is to come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary. The end of it *shall be* with a flood, and till the end of the war desolations are determined. *Dan.9:26*
- Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for **one week**; But in **the middle of the week** he shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering. And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate, even until the consummation, which is determined, is poured out on the desolate.” *Dan.9:27*

- **Why** there is a very big gap after the 62 weeks?
- **Romans 11:25** For I do not desire, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own opinion, that blindness in part has happened to Israel **until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in.**
- **When** the 70th week will resume again?
- **Matthew 24:42** Watch therefore, for you do not know what hour your Lord is coming.

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- The dragon and the beast will have authority for **42 months** *Rev.13:4-5*
- 42 months ~ 3 ½ years
- 1 week of Daniel's prophecy ~ 7 years

- "Know therefore and understand, *that* from the going forth of **the command to restore and build** Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince, *there shall be* **seven weeks** and **sixty-two weeks**; the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublesome times. *Dan.9:25*
- Daniel lived in the exile; the restoration era; Jerusalem was built again in the days of Nehemiah & Ezra
- 7 weeks + 62 weeks = 69 weeks ~ 483 years
- When Jerusalem was built again after Daniel received the prophecy?

Book of Nehemiah [\[edit\]](#)

In the 20th year of [Artaxerxes I](#) (445 or 444 BC),^[6] Nehemiah was [cup-bearer to the king](#).^[7] Learning that the remnant of Jews in Judah were in distress and that the walls of Jerusalem were broken down, he asked the king for permission to return and rebuild the city.^[8] around 20 years after [Ezra's](#) arrival in Jerusalem in 468 BC.^[9] Artaxerxes sent him to Judah as governor of the province with a mission to rebuild, letters explaining his support for the venture, and provision for timber from the king's forest.^[10] Once there, Nehemiah defied the opposition of Judah's enemies on all sides—[Samaritans](#), [Ammonites](#), [Arabs](#) and [Philistines](#)—and rebuilt the walls within 52 days, from the Sheep Gate in the North, the [Hananee Tower](#) at the North West corner, the Fish Gate in the West, the Furnaces Tower at the Temple Mount's South West corner, the [Dung Gate](#) in the South, the East Gate and the gate beneath the [Golden Gate](#) in the East.

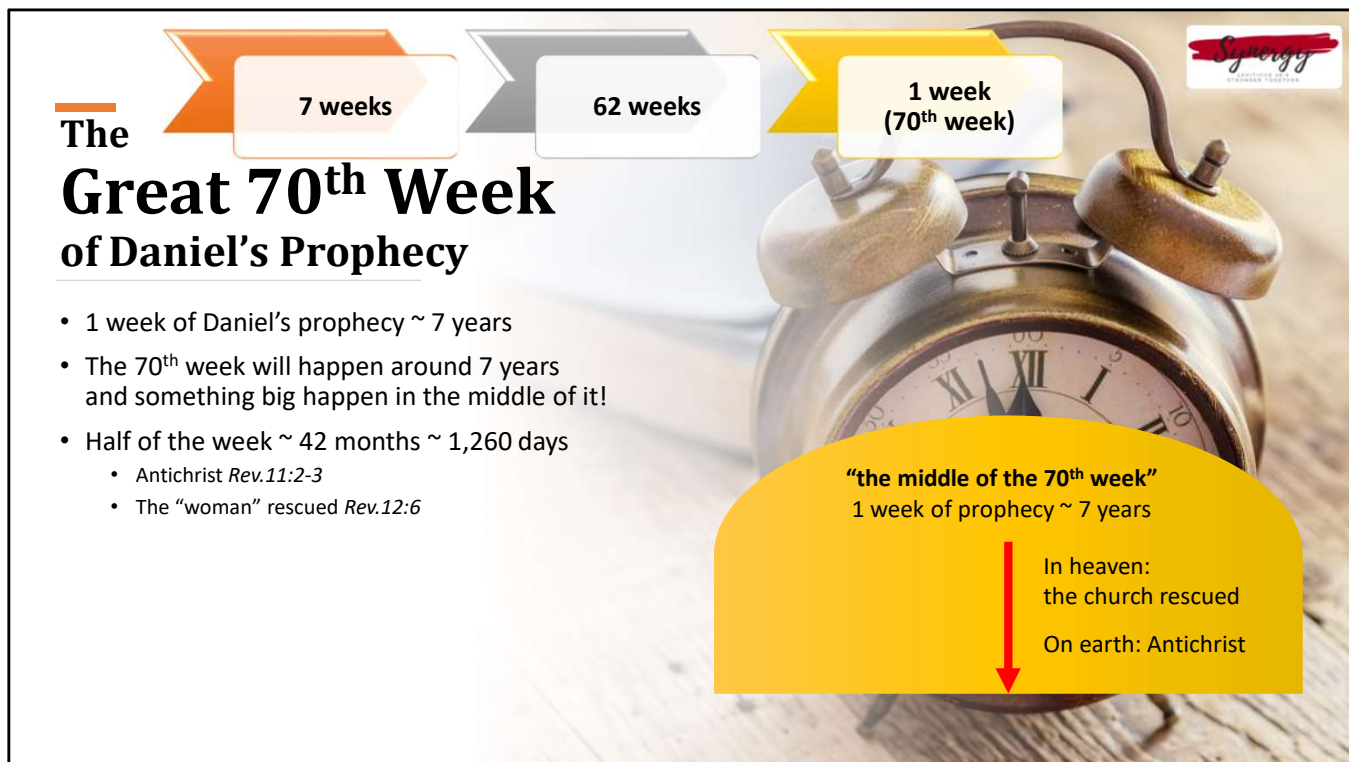

There is no consensus regarding the exact date of the crucifixion of Jesus, although it is generally agreed by biblical scholars that it was on a [Friday](#) on or near [Passover](#) ([Nisan 14](#)), during the governorship of Pontius Pilate (who ruled AD 26–36).^[83] Various approaches have been used to estimate the year of the crucifixion, including the canonical Gospels, the chronology of the life of Paul, as well as different [astronomical](#) models. Scholars have provided estimates in the range 30–33 AD,^{[84][85][86]} with [Rainer Riesner](#) stating that "the fourteenth of Nisan (7 April) of the year A.D. 30 is, apparently in the opinion of the majority of contemporary scholars as well, far and away the most likely date of the crucifixion of Jesus."^[87] Another preferred date among scholars is Friday, April 3, 33 AD.^{[88][89]}
