- 5. Remember the perseverance of Job, the Lord is very compassionate and merciful


However, living in the middle of all those uncertainties for


quite long moment is definitely not easy, so that Job struggled with respecting his own life, he was up and down to see that he is precious in God's sight.


Do you hate your life? Please do not harm yourselves because indeed God loves you, even more than you ever know!

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

Romans 8:32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?







Do not curse your marriage, do not curse your family, do not curse the location where you live now, do not curse your school, do not curse your university, do not curse your family, do not curse your kids, do not curse your job, do not course your neighbourhood, do not curse your suburb, and so on!

Bitterness is Dangerous!

JOB 6 – FEEL NO HOPE

9 That it would please God to crush me, that He would loose His hand and cut me off!

11 "What strength do I have, that I

should hope? And what is my end, that I should prolong my

life?

If you feel something like this, you are not alone!

Job was there as well!

Hang in there until we learn why God let all of that burden happened.

JOB 9 - LABOUR IN VAIN

²⁹ If I am condemned, why then do I labour in vain? ³⁰ If I wash myself with snow water, and cleanse my hands with soap, ³¹ Yet You will plunge me into the pit, and my own clothes will abhor me.



JOB 10 - HATE HIS LIFE

¹ "My soul loathes my life; I will give free course to my complaint, I will speak in the bitterness of my soul. ² I will say to God, 'Do not condemn me; Show me why You contend with me.

JOB 17 – NO FUTURE ANYMORE


¹¹ My days are past,

As for my hope, who can see it?




JOB 38

Job, Elijah, Jeremiah ELIJAH – 1KINGS 19 4 But he himself went a day's journey into the wilderness, and came and sat down under a broom tree. And he prayed that he might die, and said, "It is enough! Now, Lord, take my life, for I am no better than my fathers!"





The burden in our life may give us the same feelings!

Why there are burdens so heavy?

- 1. It may happen because of **transgression** Lam.1:14 and "The yoke of my transgressions was bound; They were woven together by His hands, And thrust upon my neck. He made my strength fail; The Lord delivered me into the hands of those whom I am not able to withstand.
- 2. It may happen for another reasons!

God is Always in Control JOB 1 6 Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan also came among them. 7 And the LORD said to Satan, "From where do you come?" So Satan answered the LORD and said, "From going to and fro on the earth, and from walking back and forth on it." 8 Then the LORD said to Satan, "Have you considered My servant Job, that there is none like him on the earth, a blameless and upright


It is **very important** to know that it was God who **initiate the conversation** (not the disaster).

man, one who fears God and shuns evil?"


Because God is so pleased with the life of Job, so that God don't hide His feeling toward Job.

Matthew 3:17 And suddenly a voice came from heaven, saying, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased."




Satan always full with envy!

Even though there is almost nothing left in our life, but still God can make something out from nothing!

Out from Nothing!

JOB 42

¹⁰ And **the Lord restored Job's losses** when he prayed for his friends. Indeed the Lord gave Job **twice as much as he had before**.

¹² Now the LORD **blessed the latter** *days* **of Job more than his beginning**; for he had fourteen thousand sheep, six thousand camels, one thousand yoke of oxen, and one thousand female donkeys. ¹³ He also had seven sons and three daughters.

¹⁶ After this Job lived one hundred and forty years, and saw his children and grandchildren for four generations. ¹⁷ So Job died, old and full of days.



Compared to Elijah:

Because of Jezebel, Elijah had to run for his life, lived in the wilderness, and he prayed that he might die, and he said: It is enough! Now, Lord, take my life.


But then we understand that Elijah continued his life in the fulness of God's plan until he ascended to heaven! Suddenly a chariot of fire appeared with horses of fire, and separated Elijah from Elisha; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven 2Kings 2:11.

Compared to Jeremiah:



- 2. Prophecy about what would happen at the birth of Messiah *Jer.31:15*, *Mat.2:17-18*
- 3. Prophecy about what would happen at the death of

Messiah *Jer.32:6-9, Mat.27:9-10*
