Let's together be ready for the harvest time and do not delay.

We are going to learn from John chapter 4. Jesus showed us that it is so simple and so natural for believers to be a blessing for others and collect the harvest.



Blessing in Disguise!



JOHN 4

³ Jesus left Judea and departed again to Galilee. ⁴ But He needed to go through Samaria.

⁵ So He came to a city of Samaria which is called Sychar, near the plot of ground that Jacob gave to his son Joseph. ⁶ Now Jacob's well was there. Jesus therefore, being wearied from His journey, sat thus by the well. It was about the sixth hour.

Keyword: The readiness to harvest will bring believers to experience blessing in disguise. Harvest is not merely a project, instead it is a **life style**!

John chapter 4 is about the big revival in Samaria. But actually Samaria **was not the destination** of the journey of Jesus and his disciples. It is just a **stopover** (a break in a journey).

Again, the harvest is truly plenty, it is **everywhere**! And the time of harvest is already commenced!

The revival is Samaria was not actually expected and was not planned beforehand. Jesus always focus for the children of Israel first. Even up to the day of Ascension, Jesus still said that they must witness first in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and Samaria, and then to the end of the earth *Ac.1:8*. But then what happened in the city of Samaria at that moment was an evidence that truly the harvest is always plentiful!

Even, also at that moment Jesus and the disicples were in **break time**. Jesus was being wearied from His journey, and the disciples were not there because they must find some food to buy.

"Give Me a drink."

"Give me a drink" was a very short sentence with a huge impact!

Overcome The Barrier & Start to Speak Something

- 1. Ego barrier: open up your condition, no need to hide your situation, and also a readiness to be rejected
- 2. Gender barrier 1Tim.5:1-2
- 3. Culture / tradition barrier, no racism, no discriminations
- 4. Language barrier

So that we can be a blessing to other people, **we must speak in their language** so that other can understand. Otherwise, they will never be able to understand!

1Corinthians 14

discourage: cause (someone) to lose confidence or enthusiasm

Sometimes we may receive a discouraging answer. But do not lose heart, do not give up! Why? Because actually we are talking with someone that need Jesus. We can keep in our mind that all of that discouraging attitudes and answers will change when they receive Jesus!

The **Turning Point**

JOHN 4

¹⁵ The woman said to Him, "Sir, give me this water, that I may not thirst, nor come here to draw."



The Turning Point

We never know when is the turning point of someone come to Jesus.

Illust: the ministry of Jim Yost (the American man with an Indonesian heart).

In the case of that Samaritan woman, the turning point happened at the same day.

In another case, the turning point may happen at the following days, months, or even years. We never know, but still Jesus said that the harvest truly plentiful!




