

How low **OR** how high is your boringness level? What is boring?


We can not expect kindie students to sit in a 2-days financial planning seminar.


 According to Jewish tradition, Solomon wrote Song of Solomon during his younger years, Proverbs in his middle years, and Ecclesiastes during the last years of his life.


- The accumulative effect of Solomon's spiritual decline, idolatry, and life of self-indulgence left him at the end disilusionaed with pleasure and materialism as a way to happiness.
- Ecclesiastes records his cynical reflections about the futility and emptiness of seeking happiness in life apart from God and His Word.
- He had experienced wealth, power, honour, fame, and sensual pleasure – all in great abundance – yet they added up in the end to emptiness and disillusionment: "Vanity of vanities ... all is vanity"

<u>Unless</u> God open the eyes of our heart, everything just looks like **a circle of vanity**!

People may see the generations (either past, present, or emerging generation) as a circle of vanity. But truly that is not what actually happen in the presence of God.

**Psalm 78:4** We will not hide them from their children, telling to the generation to come the praises of the Lord, and His strength and His wonderful works that He has done.

<sup>8</sup> All things *are* full of labor; Man cannot express *it*. The eye is not satisfied with seeing, nor the ear filled with hearing.



### What is the Purpose of This Book Then?

- Share his regrets
- Firsthand testimony
- Last great thing before finish line
- A powerful warning sign for believers from generation to generation



His primary purpose in writing Ecclesiastes may have been to share his regrets and his firsthand testimony with others before he died, especially with young people, so that they would not make the same mistakes he had.

He establishes forever the utter futility (complete uselessness) of basing one's values in life on earthly possessions and personal ambition.

**BEFORE:** King Solomon lived his life purposefully. **1Kings 4:32-34** 

<sup>32</sup> He spoke three thousand proverbs, and his songs were one thousand and five. <sup>33</sup> Also he spoke of trees, from the cedar tree of Lebanon even to the hyssop that springs out of the wall; he spoke also of animals, of birds, of creeping things, and of fish. <sup>34</sup> And men of all nations, from all the kings of the earth who had heard of his wisdom, came to hear the wisdom of Solomon. **32** Ia menggubah tiga ribu amsal, dan nyanyiannya ada seribu lima.

**33** Ia bersajak tentang pohon-pohonan, dari pohon aras yang di gunung Libanon sampai kepada hisop yang tumbuh pada dinding batu; ia berbicara juga tentang hewan dan tentang burung-burung dan tentang binatang melata dan tentang ikan-ikan.

King Solomon just loved so many things in his life and it was **the biggest & the most dangerous trap** in his life! Why?

<sup>5</sup> For Solomon went after Ashtoreth the goddess of the Sidonians, and after Milcom the abomination of the Ammonites.

<sup>6</sup> Solomon **did evil in the sight of the Lord**, and **did not fully follow the Lord**, as did his father David.

<sup>7</sup> Then Solomon built a high place for Chemosh the abomination of Moab, on the hill that is east of Jerusalem, and for Molech the abomination of the people of Ammon.

King Solomon did not live in the favour of God anymore because he had turned away his heart far from God.

He tried to find happiness and satisfaction but **it all failed**!

<sup>8</sup>I also gathered for myself silver and gold and the special treasures of kings and of the provinces. I acquired male and female singers, the delights of the sons of men, *and* musical instruments of all kinds.

<sup>9</sup> So I became great and excelled more than all who were before me in Jerusalem. Also my wisdom remained with me.

<sup>10</sup> Whatever my eyes desired I did not keep from them.

I did not withhold my heart from any pleasure,

For my heart rejoiced in all my labor;

And this was my reward from all my labor.

<sup>11</sup> Then I looked on all the works that my hands had done And on the labor in which I had toiled;




