**GENESIS 1** <sup>31</sup> Then God saw everything that He had made, and **indeed it was very good**. So the evening and the morning were the sixth day.




At first, everything was very good, indeed!

## ALL THINGS WELL!

MARK 7 <sup>37</sup> And they were astonished beyond measure, saying, “**He has done all things well.** He makes both the deaf to hear and the mute to speak.”



Jesus, the Son of God, did all things well! Just like what Father God had done in the beginning.

**ACTS 1** <sup>6</sup> Therefore, when they had come together, they asked Him, saying, “**Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?**”

### Prologue

<sup>1</sup> The former account I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach,

<sup>2</sup> until the day in which [\[a\]](#) He was taken up, after He through the Holy Spirit had given commandments to the apostles whom He had chosen,

<sup>3</sup> to whom He also presented Himself alive after His suffering by many [\[b\]](#) infallible proofs, being seen by them during forty days and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God.

### The Holy Spirit Promised

<sup>4</sup> And being assembled together with *them*, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, “which,” *He said*, “you have heard from Me;

<sup>5</sup> for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now.”

<sup>6</sup> Therefore, when they had come together, they asked


Him, saying, “Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?”


## LORD, WILL YOU?


<sup>16</sup> The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that **we are children of God,**


