JEREMIAH 1 ¹ The words of Jeremiah **the son of Hilkiah, of the priests** who were **in Anathoth in the land of Benjamin**, ² to whom the word of the Lord came **in the days of Josiah** the son of Amon, king of Judah, in the thirteenth year of his reign. ³ It came also in the days of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah, king of Judah, until the end of the eleventh year of Zedekiah the son of Josiah, king of Judah, **until the carrying away of Jerusalem captive in the fifth month.**



He knows your family – son of Hilkiah, the priest
He knows where you live – Anathoth, the land of Benjamin
He knows when you live – the days of Josiah, Jehoiakim,
Zedekiah, the captive

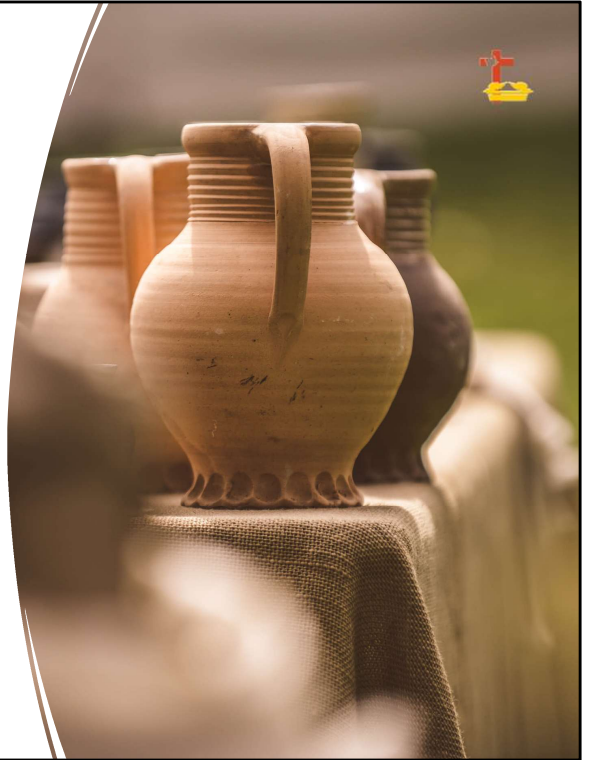

1CORINTHIANS 14:3 But he who **prophesies** speaks edification and exhortation and comfort to men.

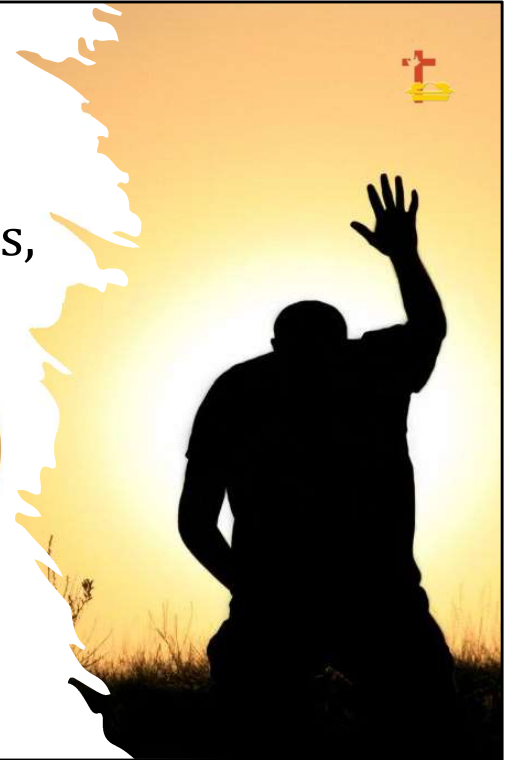

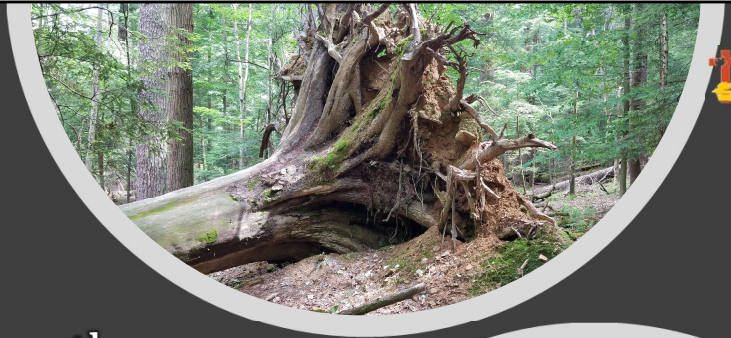
⁹ Then the Lord put forth His hand and touched my mouth, and the Lord said to me: "Behold, I have put **My words in your mouth.**

¹⁰ See, I have this day set you over the nations and over the kingdoms, **to root out and to pull down, to destroy and to throw down, to build and to plant."**





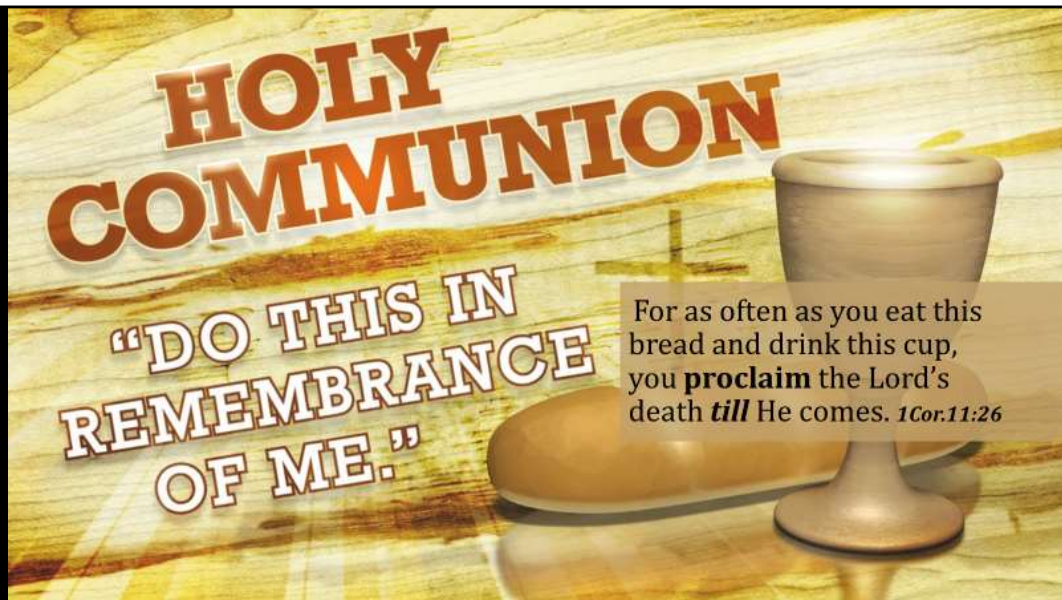


2CORINTHIANS 10


